1. Who is responsible for the processing of your data?

The responsible for the treatment of the personal data collected on this website is LA SALA DALIAS S.L., with address in Ctra. San Carlos, KM. 12, 07850 Santa Eularia des Riu - Ibiza (Balearic Islands). You can contact our Privacy Manager at privacy@lasdalias.es

2. What personal information do we get?

The data used are those obtained from its registration in the Wi-Fi internet access service of LAS DALIAS.

The categories of data we process typically consist of:

- Identification and contact information;
- Personal characteristics data, such as gender, date and country of birth, nationality and language.

3. Why do we treat your data?

The data we obtain will be used for the provision of access service, security management and performance thereof. We also use them to send commercial communications to the emails provided and for the realization of statistics and improvement of the quality of our products and services.

4. Who can we communicate your data to?

We will only communicate your data by legal obligation or with your previous consent.

5. Legal basis of the treatments

The data processing is based on compliance with the contractual relationship and our legitimate interest in the management of the proper functioning and security of our systems.

The sending of offers and commercial communications to the emails provided are based on your consent, without the withdrawal of such consent conditions the provision of the contracted services.

6. How long will we keep your data?

The data used for the management of the service will be kept as long as it is necessary for the management of your connection.

The data processed for commercial purposes are kept active as long as the interested party does not revoke their consent or request their deletion and, in any case, during the periods established in the applicable legal provisions and for the time necessary to attend to possible responsibilities arising from the treatment. The files that show the existence of your consent for the processing of your data for these purposes, such as signed forms, logs for sending electronic forms, will be kept for the entire duration of the treatments and the applicable prescription periods.

7. What are your rights?

You have the right to obtain confirmation of whether or not we are dealing with your personal data and, in that case, accessing it. You can also request that your data be rectified when inaccurate or that incomplete data is completed, as well as requesting its deletion when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

In certain circumstances, you may request the limitation of the processing of your data. In that case, we will only deal with the data affected for the formulation, exercise or defense of claims or for the protection of the rights of other people.

In certain conditions and for reasons related to your particular situation, you may also oppose the processing of your data. In this case, we will stop processing the data except for legitimate reasons that prevail over your interests or rights and freedoms, or for the formulation, exercise or defense of claims.

You may revoke the consent you have provided for certain purposes, without affecting the legality of the treatment based on previous consent to your withdrawal, and present a complaint to the Spanish Data Protection Agency.

Likewise and under certain conditions you can request the portability of your data to be transmitted to another person in charge of the treatment.

To exercise your rights, you must send us a request via postal mail or e-mail to the addresses indicated in the section "Who is responsible for the processing of your data?". This request must be accompanied by a copy of your national identity document or other valid document that identifies you. You must send it by postal mail or e-mail to the addresses indicated in the section "Who is responsible for the processing of your data?".
